

Frank McNichol

Frank was born in Liverpool in 1911. At the age of 17 he joined *ARK* Scenic Studios where he painted and designed scenery and settings for many leading theatrical productions. Following the Second World War he continued to work in the theatre for a further two years before moving on to the new developing industry in exhibition stand design working on murals and interiors for some of the foremost companies in the country. As the years went by he decided that he wanted to become a professional artist and in 1969 he moved to Port Gaverne and pursued his love of painting up until he died in 2003.

A permanent memorial to Frank in the form of an engraved and sculped slate is now fixed over the bridge at The Main at Port Gaverne.
