PARISH COUNCIL At the meeting on the 13th. it was learned that the light at Mayfield Road was awaiting news from SWEB. Some Fire Hydrants have been attended to already. Mr. Julian is to be asked to quote for painting the 'graffiti-ised' bus shelter. The CB Club are to make up a donation of £100 towards the E. Cornwall Hosp. Fund and that the collecting box at the surgery raised £15.95 for the same cause. The Lifeboat Committee are prepared to organise the Film Show (see last issue). There is still no Seat at lower Trefreock but this will be remedied. Reports of Bad TV Reception will be investigated next month and possibility of 'booster' station discussed. Also at next meeting (in Trelights) possibility of planting shrubs at entrance to new 'estate' at Trelights. A 2p. Rate is to be levied again. Further news of Overhead Lines at Playing Fields and Parking Restrictions in Fore Street will be available soon. The Parish Council expressed gratitude to the Port Gaverne Hotel and the Golden Lion for the Christmas Tree by Port Isaac Post Office the last two years, and will be making the arrangements for the tree this year.
