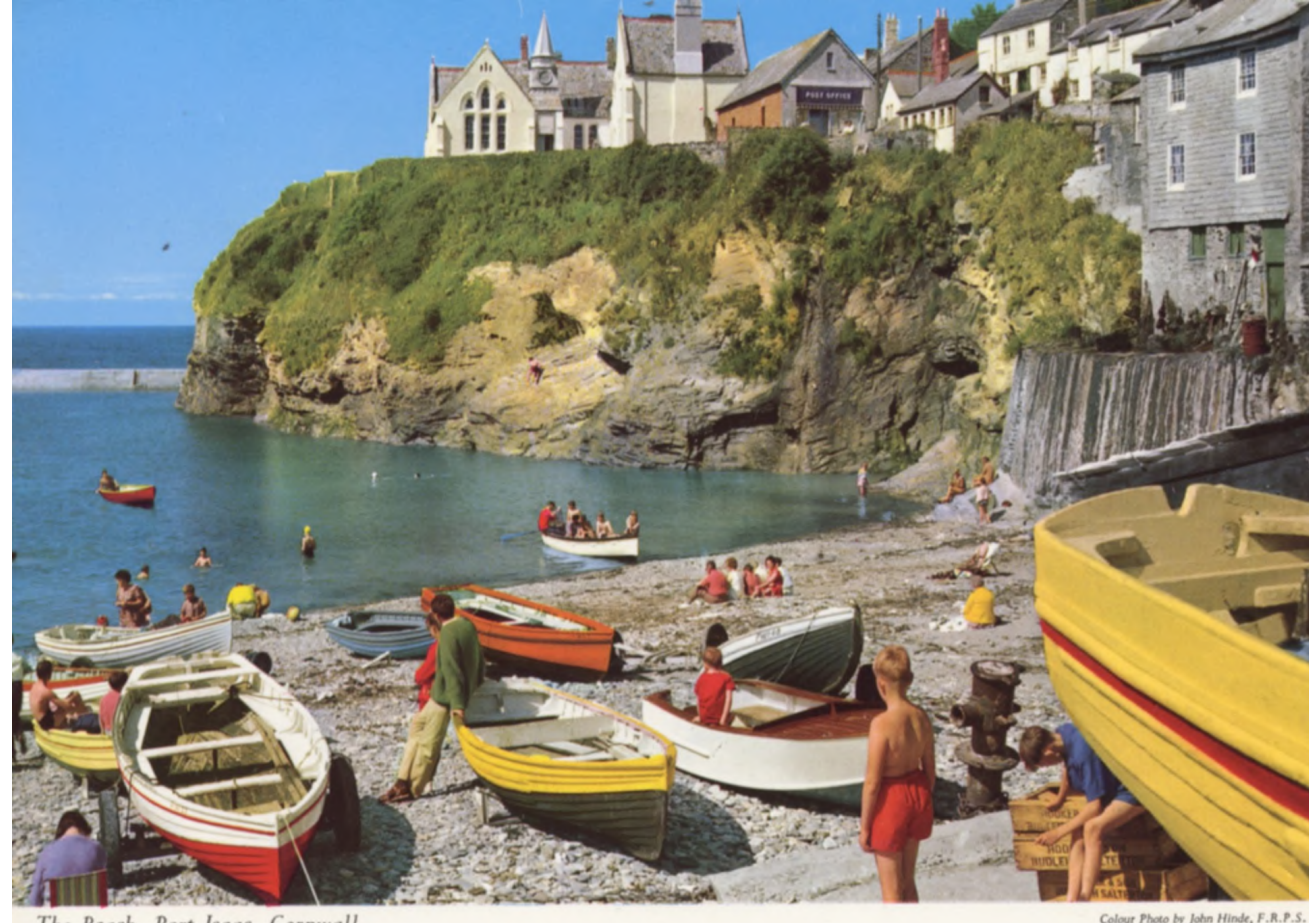


# A mist that from the moor arose In sea fog wraps Port Isaac Bay

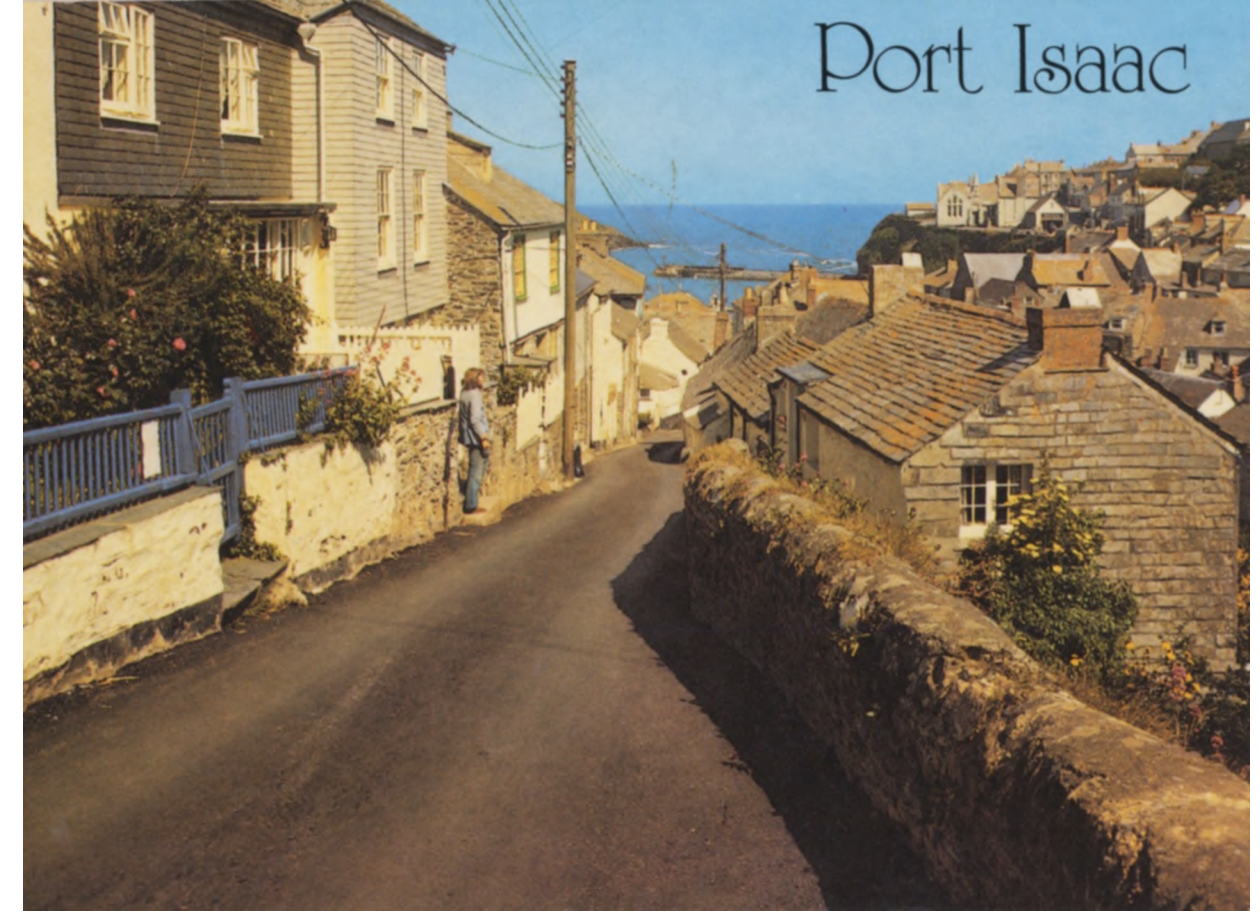

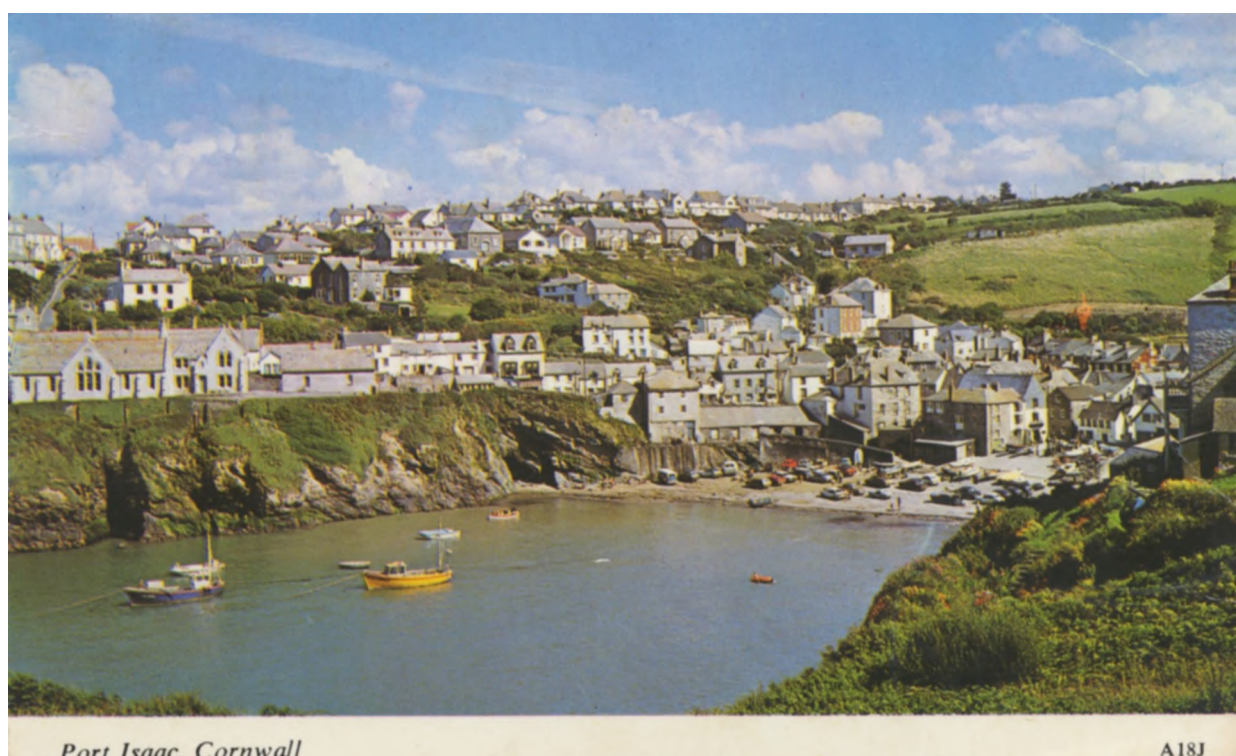
