## Semaine du Golfe du Morbihan



In 2015, Port Isaac Rowing Club took *Unity* and Corsair across the channel to take part this magnificent five-day festival, located in Southern Brittany's Golfe du Morbihan.

All types and sizes sailing and rowing boats gather and explore different routes in and around the beautiful Breton harbour.
