Annie Philp remembers her dear friend:

"I presume Frank was in the Yeomanry Division of Devon from the items I was given on his death.

The receptionist at the Duke of Cornwall Light Infantry (DCLI) headquarters told me that when the DCLI had enough soldiers, the men would then join the nearest division in need of soldiers; perhaps this is what happened to Frank?

My memories of any conversations about Frank's war service were not in any detail but I understood he had a very bad time, was in the front line fighting and suffered very badly health-wise for the rest of his life."




