

1 Canadian Terrace & Peg's Folly

Canadian Terrace was built towards the end of the 19th century to commemorate the return of an emigrant from Canada.

The stone house with blue windows was once the home of Miss Beaumont.

The white cottage next door is 'Peg's Folly'. Peggy Hills remembers that she and husband Tom bought the cottage fromMr & Mrs Thomas. There was no indoor bathroom and only electric downstairs. During renovation they found the old cloam oven but as soon as they tried to move it, it fell to bits.
