



7 & 8 Overcliff

These two houses, and the cliff path that runs around them, were built in the early 1970s on land belonging to Mrs Hilson. Mrs Hilson's house was at the top of the cliff and was a tall, detached building with bow windows. It is said that the present gate of number 8 is the original gate from Mrs Hilson's house.

If you look at the houses from the top of Lobber across the bay, you can clearly see two deep caves running into the cliff near these two houses. People say Mrs Hilson could hear the boom of the waves in the westerly gales crashing into these caves below her house . The present owners confirm that this is true.

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
