St Samsons was a store for paraffin lamps

Dolphin Public House - Behind the inn was "Cock-a-Doodle Alley", much used by courting couples. There was a 28ft deep covered well here, with a rocking chair over.

Vesta Cottage was formerly Dr Trevan's stables

Cowhouse below Bark House - cows used to be moved daily from here to meadow above Rose Hill. There are postcards showing them by First & Last.

Bark House was formerly the Labour Exchange

May House kept donkeys in back garden, the filled in archway is still visible.

Port Isaac School of Navigation was opposite Temple Bar at the turn of the century. The young men used to start at 9 o'clock sharp.

Mrs Ralph's Chip Shop - during war. She had two big alsation dogs.
