

Port Isaac Village Hall, Trewetha Lane



This large stone building was built in 1895 as the Temperance Hall for religious activities. In 2003 the Hall received a radical makeover from the TV programme, *DIY SOS*.

Over a hundred years later the Hall is still well used and caters for all types of events - dances, concerts, fundraisers, meals, sales, pantomimes, theatre to name but a few. It is also the weekly venue for the Port Isaac Stay & Play group and the Port Isaac Chorale.
