

The Fish Cellars

The Fish Cellars have probably been rebuilt and adapted many times on the same site over the centuries. Although not the oldest buliding in the village, they are historically very important to the village.

The slatestone rubble sheds were constructed around a central courtyard where the fishermen could work protected from the weather. Today the cellars are run by Port Isaac Fisherman Ltd and used by all the fishermen. The original smoke house now sells crab and lobster. There is also a wet fish shop and the Port Isaac Aquarium.
