This cottage was purchased by Mrs Vane for £340 in 1938. Two or three years previously it had been offered to a local person for just £50!

Mrs Vane's grandson, Tony, has deeds from 1764 showing that it was once two cottages, one having been used to store salt. Before ice and refrigeration, salt was the common method of preserving meat and fish. In the early 19th century, boats would have sailed to South Brittany to get salt.
