



Trevan House, Dolphin Street

Dating from the 1700s, this was the home of Dr Frederick Trevan (he also at some time lived next door in Vesta Cottage). One of ten Trevan children, he and two siblings became doctors. He trained at St Bartholomew's in London and then returned to Port Isaac to become the village doctor. His brother, John Watts Trevan, wrote the 'Summary of Memoirs of the Parish of St Endellion prior to the year 1834'.
