PORT Isaac lifeboat was called out twice on Saturday afternoon.

The first call was to assist in a search for a missing child at Daymer Bay. The child was found before the lifeboat reached the scene.

While the lifeboat was returning to Station, two windsurfers were reported to be in difficulties — one off Polzeath, and the other be-

tween Pentire Point and Newland.

Port Isaac lifeboat picked up Mark Hudson, and put him ashore at Daymer Bay. The other windsurfer, who turned out to be Mark's brother Christopher, was taken aboard a passing boat.

Port Isaac lifeboat's crew members were Neville Andrews, Greg Hingley and John Collins.
